The Santa Barbara Zoo Welcomes Four New Board Members

(May 29, 2024) Santa Barbara, CA - The <u>Santa Barbara Zoo</u> is pleased to announce four new members have joined the Board of Directors: **Mitch Avila, Sarah Berkus Gower, Bob Looney**, and **Robyn Parker**. The Zoo's Board of Directors works together to serve and support the Zoo's mission and dedication to the preservation, conservation, and enhancement of the natural world and its living treasures through education, research, and recreation.

Mitch Avila is Provost at California State University Channel Islands where he is leading the conversation to adopt a multi-year strategic enrollment plan and expansion of academic programs. He has three decades of experience in the CSU system at four campuses, including five years' experience as Dean of the College of Arts and Humanities at California State University Dominguez Hills. In that role, Avila served on the Council of Colleges of Arts and Sciences Board of Directors, where he promoted advocacy efforts for federal funding for the arts, humanities, and sciences. As Associate Dean and Chair of the Philosophy Department at Cal State Fullerton, Avila directed professional development for adjunct faculty, expanded study abroad programs, reorganized cultural centers, and developed innovative new degrees, including Vietnamese Studies. He holds a PhD in Philosophy from UC Santa Barbara (1993) and researches theories of human rights and global justice, along with the aesthetics of film and photography.

Sarah Berkus Gower practiced as an attorney at Hollister & Brace with a focus in complex litigation for over a decade and now enjoys the flexibility of legal consulting and volunteering. She holds degrees from USC's Marshall School of Business and the University of Denver Sturm College of Law, as well as Certificates in ESG and Sustainability from UC Berkeley Law and Stanford Earth. She is also a licensed California real estate agent. Sarah served six years on the Santa Barbara Botanic Garden's Board of Trustees, where she played key roles in the planning and development of the "Backcountry" children's garden. She also served as Co-Chair of the Santa Barbara Yacht Club Yachts of Love Charity Regatta benefitting Visiting Nurse and Hospice Care. She is actively involved in the Cold Spring Elementary School Parent Club and a new member of the Zoofari Ball Committee. Sarah is a third generation Santa Barbarian and is a lover of all things outdoors. She enjoys traveling, skiing, and spending time at the Zoo with her husband Hayden and son Luca.
